

Hydropad gutter options – Flip Screens

Removes and De-waters Solid Waste

The flip screen is a fantastic solution for a tough problem; grass clippings in turf equipment cleaning applications. The flip screen is installed inside all the Hydropad gutters. Each one forms a screen basin that's as large as the gutter with about 8 square feet of screen area. Water and debris flow off the side of the Hydropad into the flip screen. Debris forms a mat on the screen while wash water flows through and into the gutter where it flows by gravity to a sump tank and is removed with a pump. When the screen is full of debris, it is flipped by rotating up and out of gutter. Dewatered debris adjacent to gutter is then easily collected for disposal.



From grass clippings to cans and bottles the flip screen provides a solids separation solution that is used in a wide variety of applications.

Flip screens eliminate clogged sumps forever!



This picture illustrates why grass clippings easily clog pumps and lines. Notice how dry the waste material is light and easy to land fill.



Flip screens on this 14' wide by 24' long Hydropad above ground steel containment wash rack are in the clean out position. Pull back the handle to flip the screen and clean out the collected grass and debris. Quick and easy screen maintenance. Return the flip screens to the operating position and shovel dewatered debris.
